1	Removal of Unlicensed Equipment	If Advantage does not submit new licence applications by October 2, 2006, it must remove the unlicensed equipment by October 2, 2006. At the 5-13 site this includes four oil storage tanks, the water injection component, the group treater, and the group separator. At the 16-11 and 3-12 sites, this includes the test separator.	S.8, paragraph 5, P. 18	EUB to lift suspension in order for equipment to be removed. EUB to follow up with an inspection to ensure unlicensed equipment has been removed.	<i>Complete.</i> Advantage has completed additional public consultation and submitted new applications for the Board's consideration. The three new applications are 1481043, 1481044, and 1481045.
2	Operation Under Suspended Conditions	Until October 2, 2006, and as per the EUB's letters dated October 7, 19, and November 5, 2004, the 5-13 site may only be operated as a sweet single well oil battery with compression to conserve the solution gas. In addition, the 16-11 and 3-12 satellites may only be operated as sweet single well oil batteries.	S.8, paragraph 5, P. 19	EUB will inspect the facilities to ensure they are being operated under suspended conditions from time of release of Decision Report to October 2, 2006.	<i>Complete.</i> April 20, 2006, field inspection complete. Inspection confirmed that Advantage is operating these facilities under suspended conditions.
