WHEREAS licence numbers 39427,39428,39429, 43961, 51055, 51056, 52719,52773, 52775,52777, 53285, 53287, 54531, 54599 and 54769 have been issued under the *Pipeline Act* to Nexen authorizing the construction and operation of pipelines (Licences);

WHEREAS the Alberta Energy Regulator received information from Nexen dated August 25, 2015 advising of various non-compliances with the Licences;

WHEREAS the Alberta Energy Regulator is of the opinion that there has been or is a contravention of the *Pipeline Act*, *the Pipeline Rules* and the Licences;

WHEREAS Erin Maczuga, Director Compliance and Enforcement, has been authorized to issue orders under the *Pipeline Act* (Director).

THEREFORE, I, Erin Maczuga, Director, pursuant to section 29(1)(b) of the *Pipeline Act* do hereby order:

1. Operations authorized under the Licences are suspended effective immediately and shall remain suspended until this Order is rescinded in writing by the Alberta Energy Regulator.
